Scientific:

HISTORY OF THE VENUE (PESHAWAR: THE CITY OF FLOWERS AND HOSPITALITY)

The history of Peshawar, the capital of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, goes back as far as at least 539 BC, making it the oldest living city in Pakistan and one of the oldest in South and Central Asia. According to the historian, Tertius Chandler, Peshawar consisted of a population of 120,000 in the year AD 100, making it a major city and the seventh-most populous city in the world at that time.
